Dear Praying Friends,

I thank God for all our faithful supporters each month. God has been so good in providing for our need. He is Jehovah-Jireh as He has provided yet another need in our life, and I am sure many others that we never know about. I know many of you are probably wondering what special need I am talking about as I left you with a cliffhanger in the last prayer letter and only sent pastors the letter describing the need. I apologize for that, but I will update you now.

If you have been reading our letters for long, you know we have been doing some much needed renovations to our home in Butte. We completed everything that we could financially do but one item we thought we could get by with for a while turned into a larger problem. We had no duct work for our furnace in part of the house. Our plan was to use space heaters to supplement where needed. We ended up with three running all day and night with some extreme cold we had. As a result, our electric/gas bill went from under \$200 to well over \$300 in December and then over \$400 in early January. This is not something that we could maintain for the duration of the winter. That's where the need come in.

I sent out a **special need letter** in early January to try and get some help financially to be able to install the duct work that we needed to heat the rest of the house. Our family is humbled at how all of the funding and even some extra came in before the end of January. We were able to get the duct work installed and we now have heat throughout the entire house! We are expecting our bill to drop drastically from January to February. God is faithful and I and my family are thankful for every church and individual who God was able to use to meet this need in our lives! Thank YOU!

As for the church plant, Grace Baptist Church is keeping a steady group and we are working through new members classes at the moment with four that are interested in joining. We are looking forward to the completion of the classes in a few weeks. With the abundance of snow and sub-freezing temperatures, it has been very difficult to get out and knock doors, but we are planning to get back out when the weather starts getting better. We have had a couple visitors over the past few months, but we want to get back out canvassing as soon as we can so we can see even more. Keep praying for us as we follow the Lord's will here in Butte and know we are thankful for each of you!
